Thank you for supporting our efforts in Haiti.

One of the first messages we received from our partner Mission of Hope after the earthquake in Haiti was that the 1.5 million Stop Hunger Now meals that were shipped in December were being used to feed earthquake victims. Stop Hunger Now has been supporting Haitian relief organizations for 12 years, since its inception, and in the last four years alone has provided 6 million meals and \$4 million of in kind aid to our partners.

Since the earthquake, Stop Hunger Now has received more than 200 tons of water, food and medical supplies and is working diligently with our in-country partners to distribute this aid to those in need in Haiti.

Among the critical supplies donated and being shipped so far:

- 157,416 bottles of purified water donated by [Cott Beverages USA](#).
- 120,960 cans of ready-to-eat Underwood B-B-Q chicken and roast beef donated by [B&G Foods](#).
- More than 1 million Stop Hunger Now meals are positioned in SHN warehouses ready for shipment
- Three full pallets of rice from Derby City Trucking

Stop Hunger Now is also assisting with coordinating the transportation and distribution of more than 56 tons of medical supplies and aid obtained by the North Carolina Conference of the United Methodist Church.

We are so grateful for the generous outpouring of support from our volunteers, donors, supporters and partners. We are dedicated to continuing our work in Haiti, and with the generous contributions of supporters like you we will be able to continue to support the recovery of the victims of this catastrophe.

While food, water and medical supplies are greatly needed, please consider a monetary donation to assist with freight, shipping and purchasing specifically requested items. Your funds will also be used for restoration and recovery projects after the current crisis is no longer making headlines.
